CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

The Cooperative shall install and furnish an outdoor automatic light at the above rate when the light is installed on an existing pole or when only one additional pole is added. The Cooperative shall replace bulbs within a reasonable length of time (but not after regular working hours) in order to keep the light in proper working order and shall furnish electricity to operate such light. If it is necessary to install or erect more than one additional pole to install automatic outdoor light, the consumer shall pay the Cooperative an additional \$4.30 per month for each additional pole added after one for each light. If the Cooperative must install a transformer specifically for the outdoor light, the consumer shall pay an additional charge of \$6.60 per month.

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TERMS OF PAYMENT

Bills are due when rendered and are payable within twenty-five (25) days from the date of the bill. If any bill is not so paid, the Cooperative has the right to suspend service in accordance with its service regulations.

EQUALIZER ADJUSTMENT

The above charges per kWh will be increased or decreased by 0.001 cents per kWh or major fraction thereof, adjusted for line loss, in accordance with the Equalizer Adjustment Rider.

SALES TAX

Any applicable State and local sales taxes will be added to all service billed under this schedule.
