2023 Scholarship Opportunity

South River EMC will award three \$1,000 scholarships in 2023. These scholarships will be awarded to students who live in the South River EMC service area.

Objective:

To provide financial aid to qualifying South River EMC members and their children.

Eligibility:

1. Must live in a home, which receives electric service from South River EMC.
2. Must currently be a senior in high school.
3. A candidate must have a recommendation from either his or her high school principal, guidance counselor or teacher. Non-traditional students (i.e. homeschooled or December graduate) must provide a letter from their work supervisor or community college advisor.
4. Candidates must apply no later than January 26, 2023.
5. Candidates must have taken the SAT or ACT and submit scores with application.

Terms of the Scholarships:

1. Three scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded.
2. The scholarship is non-renewable.
3. The amount of the scholarship will be paid directly to the college or university attended by the recipient beginning in the fall semester.
4. Scholarship winners will be recognized at the South River EMC Annual Meeting of Members in April.
5. Scholarship winners must provide proof of acceptance, as well as their school ID number, by *June 30*.

Basis of Awards:

Factors considered in granting scholarships may include, but are not limited to: character, moral standards, citizenship, past and present academic performance (as outlined in Eligibility section), letters of recommendation, statements of career goals and qualifications and extra-curricular activities.

Selection Committee:

The scholarship committee of South River EMC will coordinate the scholarship applications and qualifications, as well as determining final recipients.
