2024 Scholarship Opportunity

South River EMC will award three \$1,000 scholarships in 2024. These scholarships will be awarded to students who live in the South River EMC service area.

Objective:

To provide financial aid to qualifying South River EMC members and their children.

Eligibility:

- 1. Must live in a home, which receives electric service from South River EMC.
- 2. Must currently be a senior in high school.
- 3. A candidate must have a recommendation from either his or her high school principal, guidance counselor or teacher. Non-traditional students (i.e. homeschooled, early college, or December graduate) must provide a letter from their work supervisor or community college advisor.
- 4. Candidates must apply no later than January 26, 2024.
- 5. Candidates must have taken the SAT or ACT and submit scores with application.

Terms of the Scholarships:

- 1. Three scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded.
- 2. The scholarship is non-renewable.
- 3. The amount of the scholarship will be paid directly to the college or university attended by the recipient beginning in the fall semester.
- 4. Scholarship winners must provide proof of acceptance, as well as their school ID number, by *June 30*.

Basis of Awards:

Factors considered in granting scholarships may include, but are not limited to: character, moral standards, citizenship, past and present academic performance (as outlined in Eligibility section), letters of recommendation, statements of career goals and qualifications and extra-curricular activities.

Selection Committee:

The scholarship committee of South River EMC will coordinate the scholarship applications and qualifications, as well as determining final recipients.
